

What to Expect for Your Vitals Study

Fullpower is conducting the Vitals study where they are comparing the accuracy of their under mattress vital signs tracker with a Medical quality system.

The test will be about 30 minutes long, but you will have to allocate one hour to allow for filling out forms, wiring for ECG and Respiration (Nasal Cannula) and removal of wires.

Upon Arrival

Once you have reached our offices at 1200 Pacific Avenue in Santa Cruz, you will call **1-831-480-4309** to let our technologist know you are here. Our technologist will then escort you to the test lab

Vitals Study

You will first be asked to fill in a questionnaire on flu like symptoms if any. The technologist will measure your temperature and oxygen saturation and if all looks acceptable will proceed to the study.

The technologist will wire up ECG leads and attach a nasal cannula. For the ECG leads, at designated places, a small cotton-tipped applicator, such as a Q-tip, will be used to clean a small patch of your skin. The cleaning paste is a little abrasive, but it is important to clean off the oils of your skin. None of this preparation should hurt.
